<b>Validity:</b>	24 months from assessment, then 12 month annual proficiency (as long as validity has not lapsed)

<b>Award Aims:</b>	
This award establishes a standard that demonstrates the level of competence in life saving to meet the needs of the Surf Coach, enabling more location and job specific training and assessment.	
<b>Award Learning outcomes:</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Demonstrate the knowledge and skills to work as a Beach Lifeguard within a beach environment</li> <li>2. Demonstrate the knowledge and skills needed to Patrol a Beach as a Lifeguard</li> <li>3. Demonstrate an understanding of the working practices that are in place when working as a Beach as a Lifeguard</li> <li>4. Demonstrate an understanding of the different communication methods available to Lifeguards</li> <li>5. Demonstrate an understanding of the basic skills and knowledge to administer basic life support.</li> <li>6. Demonstrate an understanding of the skills, knowledge and competence required to undertake first aid in an aquatic environment.</li> <li>7. Demonstrate a level of competence in paddling a surf board that would give them the capability to make a rescue as required during a surf lesson</li> </ol>	
<b>Assessment Process:</b>	
<p>This course can be Trainer Assessed</p> <p>Learners will be assessed using a variety of assessment methods. These are inclusive of, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Observation</li> <li>➤ Oral Questioning</li> <li>➤ Practical demonstration</li> </ul>	
<b>Typical format of delivery:</b>	
30 Guided Learning Hours delivered over a number of set weeks or over 4 days (please note that 30 GLH is only the minimum hours that must be delivered, if candidates require additional training then additional hours can be added on)

Guidance:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ This award will combine theory and practical activities (land and water based)</li> <li>➤ This award can be Trainer Assessed</li> <li>➤ Surf coaching requires a 1:10 ration and so must surf coaches will be operating on their own and will need to have lifesaving skills to deal with situations without immediate assistance</li> </ul>
